



DIRECTIONS TO "NTSUTY" Cottage 4 "Tree Tops"

From Durban, head North on the N2 then take Hluhluwe road towards Kosi Bay. From Gauteng, take the N17 to Bethal, then the N2 to Ermelo, Piet Retief, Pongola. After Pongola, take the Jozini turnoff. Watch for cattle and goats (and potholes) on this road! When you go through Jozini town, be sure to keep left and cross over the dam wall. Eventually you will come to a T-Junction. Turn right. This road goes all the way to the border. The last town is Manguzi before the Kosi Bay border post. Apart from holidays, usual border times are 8am – 5pm. Public holidays can extend from 6am to 6pm.

Access to Ponta d'Ouro can only be made by 4 x 4. At the border, let some air out of your tyres and keep to the right hand roads (at the moment they give an easier drive over the sandy hills). Do not worry about which road to take as they all go to Ponta D'Ouro – just select the firmest!

On arrival in the village of Ponta d'Ouro, go past the electricity office, the market on your left, up the little hill and at the cross roads, go straight over towards the campsite. Just at the camp barrier, bear right and follow the road along the side of the camp. The road bears right, up the hill – then keep right until you see the large "Welcome to Ntsuty Lda" sign. Ask personnel where to park for cottage 4 and they will assist you to unload. Go to Reception for the keys.

Have a wonderful holiday and a safe journey!

Don't forget to take vehicle registration papers, trailer papers etc., for 3rd party and temp import permits on the Mozambican side of the border. (Costs about R160)

No visas are necessary for South African or Swazi citizens.

All businesses and restaurants in Ponta D'Ouro take SA Rand as currency and there is no need to exchange.

Remember you are going to Mozambique and Ponta still shows remnants of the war years – but development is going on apace!

Enjoy the lovely beach and the clear warm water!

Special note: We have put airconditioners into the cottage but please do not use them during the day time as the electricity supply is not strong enough to have them on with other appliances. OR do not put kettle or microwave on when airconditioner is on. Switch on at night and sleep in comfort!
